

Tasks Completed During Reporting Period

The following activities associated with the RFI and IM work at the subject facility were conducted between September 19 and November 18, 2015.

- Maintained operation of the ICM system and conducted performance monitoring, including effluent sampling for VOC analysis, quarterly water level measurements, and daily system flow rate measurements.
- Preparation of the Q3 2015 - *Interim Corrective Measures Performance Monitoring Report* to be submitted in November 2015.
- Started the annual groundwater and surface water sampling event on November 16, 2015.

Difficulties Encountered During Reporting Period

No difficulties were encountered during this reporting period.

Summary of Contacts with Local (Community or Public) or Regulatory Groups

The following correspondence occurred with EPA during this reporting period:

- Owens Corning received a letter from EPA dated September 17, 2015 regarding their review of the 2014 Annual Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report dated January 30, 2015 and the Monthly Technical Progress Report dated July 28, 2008. EPA's letter requested that Owens Corning submit a vapor intrusion work plan by October 17, 2015. Owens Corning submitted a letter to EPA dated October 5, 2015 regarding the request for a vapor intrusion work plan.
- Owens Corning received an email from EPA dated September 23, 2015 notifying Owens Corning of their planned participation in the November 2015 groundwater sampling event. EPA's email requested that Owens Corning submit a schedule for the well sampling, which was submitted on October 2, 2015.
- Owens Corning received a letter from EPA dated September 24, 2015 regarding their review of the 2014 Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report dated January 30, 2015. EPA's letter requested that Owens Corning add 1,4-Dioxane to the target analyte list for all routine groundwater and surface water sampling, effluent monitoring, and treated groundwater discharge to Betsy Creek. Owens Corning submitted a letter response to EPA dated October 27, 2015 regarding this inquiry.
- Owens Corning received a letter from EPA dated September 24, 2015 regarding their review of the Baseline Human Health Risk Assessment dated March 7, 2014.
- Owens Corning received an email from EPA dated October 7, 2015 regarding the November 2015 groundwater monitoring event. EPA's email requested that Owens Corning submit a copy of the groundwater monitoring work plan. Owens Corning obliged and submitted the work plan on October 14, 2015.
- EPA was onsite November 16-17, 2015 during the annual groundwater and surface water monitoring event to conduct oversight of the sampling.
- No additional interactions with the public or with EPA/DHEC occurred during this reporting period.

Projected Work for Next Reporting Period

Owens Corning's plans for the next reporting period of November 19 through December 16, 2015 include:

- Continue operation of the ICM system and conduct required performance monitoring.
- Owens Corning awaits EPA's review and comments on the RFI Technical Memorandum and RFI Work Plan submitted on September 18, 2015.
- Complete the annual groundwater and surface water monitoring event during the week of November 16, 2015.
- Submittal of the *Q3 2015 - Interim Corrective Measures Performance Monitoring Report* on November 30, 2015.
- Conduct the semiannual residential well sampling during the week of November 23, 2015.
- Preparation of the *2015 Annual Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report* to be submitted in January 2016.
