

Tasks Completed During Reporting Period

The following activities associated with the RFI and IM work at the subject facility were conducted between July 16 and August 19, 2015.

- Maintained operation of the ICM system and conducted performance monitoring, including effluent sampling for VOC analysis, quarterly water level measurements, and daily system flow rate measurements.
- Submittal of the *2015 Semiannual Groundwater Monitoring Report* on July 30, 2015.
- Conducted the August 2015 quarterly groundwater monitoring event during the week of August 10-14, 2015.

Difficulties Encountered During Reporting Period

No difficulties were encountered during this reporting period.

Summary of Contacts with Local (Community or Public) or Regulatory Groups

Owens Corning attended a Status Update Meeting with EPA, Brown and Caldwell and South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the latter via conference call) on August 10, 2015 at EPA's offices in Atlanta, GA. The purpose of the meeting was to confirm mutual understanding on the interpretation of site data to date and to agree on a path to site closure that is protective of public health and the environment. Accordingly, Owens Corning will retract the RFI Work Plan dated June 2, 2014 and will submit a new Work Plan by late September or early October 2015. No additional interactions with the public or with EPA/DHEC occurred during this reporting period.

Projected Work for Next Reporting Period

Owens Corning's plans for the next reporting period of August 20 through September 16, 2015 include:

- Continue operation of the ICM system and conduct required performance monitoring.
- Continued preparation of the *Q2 2015 - Interim Corrective Measures Performance Monitoring Report* to be submitted in August 2015.
- Preparation of the RFI Work Plan Addendum to be submitted by late September or early October 2015.

Tasks Completed During Reporting Period

The following activities associated with the RFI and IM work at the subject facility were conducted between August 20 and September 18, 2015.

- Maintained operation of the ICM system and conducted performance monitoring, including effluent sampling for VOC analysis, quarterly water level measurements, and daily system flow rate measurements.
- Submittal of the *Q2 2015 - Interim Corrective Measures Performance Monitoring Report* on August 25, 2015.
- Submittal of the *RFI Technical Memorandum and Work Plan* which also included the Conceptual Site Model and Human Health Risk Assessment on September 18, 2015.

Difficulties Encountered During Reporting Period

No difficulties were encountered during this reporting period.

Summary of Contacts with Local (Community or Public) or Regulatory Groups

Owens Corning received a letter from EPA dated August 27, 2015 regarding their review of the Q2 2015 – Interim Corrective Measures Monitoring Report dated August 25, 2015. EPA's letter requested that Owens Corning submit a groundwater investigation work plan by October 1, 2015 which was submitted on September 18, 2015 as indicated above. No additional interactions with the public or with EPA/DHEC occurred during this reporting period.

Projected Work for Next Reporting Period

Owens Corning's plans for the next reporting period of September 19 through October 21, 2015 include:

- Continue operation of the ICM system and conduct required performance monitoring.
- Preparation of the Q3 2015 - *Interim Corrective Measures Performance Monitoring Report* to be submitted in later October or early November 2015.
